1.3+2 **Early Entry** Master's Program

- 1) MS in **Nutrition** 3+2 Program
- 2) MS in **Public Health** 3+2 Program

2.1+1 Dual Master's Program

- 1) MS in **Nutrition** 1+1 Program
- 2) MS in **Public Health** 1+1.5 Program

3+2 Program and Dual **MS** Degree in **Nutrition** with CWRU

Completed a minimum of **3** years at TMU toward a bachelor's degree

An overall GPA of at least **3.0**

Completion with a **B** or higher of courses in the following subjects:

- General Chemistry · General Biology · Biochemistry · Organic Chemistry · Statistics · Anatomy · Physiology

English qualification:

- A TOEFL score of at least **90** on internet-based version, or **577** on paper version, or IELTS score of **7.0** or above

3 letters of recommendation and a career statement as part of the completed online application

The following requirements for the MS degree must be met during the **2 years** here **at CWRU**:

- A total of **30** credits earned while in the graduate program
- A minimum of **18** credits of graduate Nutrition coursework
- Completing a thesis or completing additional electives
- A cumulative GPA of at least 2.75 during the graduate work
- All other degree requirements

3+2 Program and Dual MPH Degree with CWRU(1)

Completed a minimum of **3** years at TMU toward a bachelor's degree

An overall GPA of at least **3.0** at TMU

A phone/Skype **interview** with a member(s) of the MPH Management Team

A complete application file consisting of:

- Completed Online Application
- Personal Statement/Statement of Objectives
- Academic Transcripts

English qualification:

- TOEFL: **577**(paper-based), or **90** (Internet-based)
- IELTS: **≥ 7.0**
- The MPH Admissions Committee will also accept results from the IELTS test or completion of ELS language classes, level 112, with a cumulative GPA 3.0 or higher in lieu of the TOEFL

3 letters of recommendation and a career statement as part of the completed online application

Application fee: **\$50** (non-refundable)

3+2 Program and Dual MPH Degree with CWRU(2)

The following requirements for the MPH degree can be met during the 2 years here at CWRU:

A total of 42 credits earned while in the graduate program

A minimum of 21 credits of graduate core curriculum, including:

- Statistical Methods in Public Health · History and Philosophy of Public Health · Introduction to Behavioral Health · Environmental Health · Health Management and Policy · Introduction to Epidemiology for Public Health Practice · Research and Evaluation Methods

9 credits in one of the following degree majors:

- Population Health Research · Global Health · Health Policy and Management · Health Promotion and Disease Prevention · Health Informatics

3 credits of free electives

3 credits of Public Health Practicum (may be completed in Taiwan)

6 credits of Capstone Project (may be completed in Taiwan)

A cumulative GPA of at least 2.75 during the graduate work

All other degree requirements

1+1 Program and Dual **MS** Degree in **Nutrition** with CWRU

Completed a minimum of **1** years at TMU toward a master's degree

An overall GPA of at least **3.0**

Completion with a **B** or higher of courses in the following subjects:

- General Chemistry 、 General Biology 、 Biochemistry 、 Organic Chemistry 、 Statistics 、 Anatomy 、 Physiology

English qualification:

- A TOEFL score of at least **90** on internet-based version, or **577** on paper version, or IELTS score of **7.0** or above

3 letters of recommendation and a career statement as part of the completed online application

The following requirements for the MS degree must be met during the time here at CWRU:

- A total of an additional **24** credits earned while in the graduate program, for a total of **30** credits
- A minimum of **18** credits of graduate Nutrition coursework
- A cumulative GPA of at least 2.75 during the graduate work
- Passing of **comprehensive** exam during final semester of coursework (must be taken on CWRU campus)
- All other degree requirements

1+1.5 Program and Dual MPH Degree with CWRU(1)

Completed **1** year of graduate or professional training at TMU

An overall GPA of at least **3.0** at TMU

A phone/Skype **interview** with a member(s) of the MPH Management Team

A complete application file consisting of:

- Completed Online Application
- Personal Statement/Statement of Objectives
- Academic Transcripts
- Test Scores
 - prefers **GRE** scores, but will accept MCAT, GMAT, or LSAT scores

English qualification:

- TOEFL: **577**(paper-based), or **90**(Internet-based)
- IELTS: **≥ 7.0**
- The MPH Admissions Committee will also accept results from the IELTS test or completion of ELS language classes, level 112, with a cumulative GPA 3.0 or higher in lieu of the TOEFL

3 letters of recommendation and a career statement as part of the completed online application

Application fee: **\$50** (non-refundable)

1+1.5 Program and Dual MPH Degree with CWRU(2)

The following requirements for the MPH degree can be met during the 1.5 years at CWRU, with the possibility of some credits earned before or after residence in Cleveland:

A total of **36** additional credits earned while in the graduate program

- This, in combination with the 6 credits from TMU, will reach the program requirements of 42 credits

A minimum of **21** credits of graduate core curriculum, including:

- Statistical Methods in Public Health · History and Philosophy of Public Health · Introduction to Behavioral Health · Environmental Health · Health Management and Policy · Introduction to Epidemiology for Public Health Practice · Research and Evaluation Methods

6 credits in one of the following degree majors:

- Population Health Research · Global Health · Health Policy and Management · Health Promotion and Disease Prevention · Health Informatics

6 credits (elective plus a major course) from TMU coursework

3 credits of Public Health Practicum (may be completed **in Taiwan**)

6 credits of Capstone Project (may be completed **in Taiwan**)

A cumulative GPA of at least 2.75 during the graduate work
